EXTRACTS FROM THE INSTITUTE'S BYE-LAWS

6. Every candidate for election or transfer to the class of Fellows shall be not less than 30 years of age, have fulfilled the conditions for election or transfer to the class of Members, and have had such experience in physics or its applications for at least eight years that he shall be deemed to have made a significant contribution either to the advancement of physics or to the profession.
7. Every candidate for election or transfer to the class of Members shall be not less than 24 years of age and shall either
 - (a) have obtained an honours degree or a degree requiring a course of study of at least four academic years in duration or an equivalent qualification in physics or related subjects which is recognized by the Council, and at least three years of responsible work in physics or its applications, **or**
 - (b) have obtained a pass degree or an equivalent qualification in physics or related subjects recognized by the Council, and at least five years of responsible work in physics or its applications, **or**
 - (c) have had a satisfactory education as a physicist and at least ten years of responsible work in physics or its applications such that the Council is satisfied that he is worthy of election as a Member.
8. Every candidate for election or transfer to the class of Graduate shall be not less than 21 years of age and have obtained a degree or equivalent qualification with physics as a major subject recognized by the Council.
9. Every candidate for election or transfer to the class of Associates shall be not less than 24 years of age and have a satisfactory general education and at least five years of work which demands a knowledge of physics or its applications as shall satisfy the Council.
10. Every candidate for election to the class of Students shall satisfy the Council that he is undergoing a course of study in physics or related subjects at a recognized tertiary institution of learning.
